



# PROVERBS #1

## Trust in the Lord with all your heart

Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;  
in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight. **Proverbs 3:5-6**

- **Trust in the Lord with all your heart**

"Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God; trust also in me. **Jn.14:1**  
Faith & Trust. Trust being the practical outworking of Faith

- **Lean not on your own understanding**

Don't be wise if your own eyes

Solomon began brilliantly then began to think he was better than God (Deut 17)

"For the LORD gives wisdom, and from his mouth come knowledge and understanding.  
Prov 2:6

- **In all your ways acknowledge him**

The two significant words here are:-

**Ways** - (Hebrew "derek") – means a road, a course, a mode of action.

**Acknowledge** – (Hebrew "yada"). Elsewhere 'yada' is translated "know"

- meaning to know by observation, investigation, reflection, or first-hand  
experience. [

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with  
thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which  
transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ  
Jesus. **Phil. 4:6-7**

- **He will make your paths straight**

He will level your ground

He will guide you in the word of God

All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and  
training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for  
every good work. **2 Tim 3:16-17**

"Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads  
to destruction, and many enter through it. Matthew 7:13
